Class One	Elepidote species (large leaf species / no scales on leaves)	One truss
Class Two	Lepidote species (small leaved / scales underside of leaf)	One spray
Class Three	Lepidote hybrid	One spray
Class Four	Elepidote hybrid Red, Yellow, Pink, White, Purple/Mauve, Orange/Salmon	One truss
Class Five	Three different Elepidote trusses	Three Trusses
Class Six	Any tender species or hybrid rhododendron grown under glass or otherwise, including Vireyas	One truss or spray or displayed in pot
Class Seven	Deciduous Azalea, species or hybrid	One spray
Class Eight	Evergreen Azalea, species or hybrid	One spray
Class Nine	Camellia, species or hybrid	One bloom
Class Ten	Magnolia species or hybrid	One bloom
Class Eleven	Flowering tree or shrub (except roses)	One spray
Class Twelve	A spray of leaves from any tree or shrub	One spray
